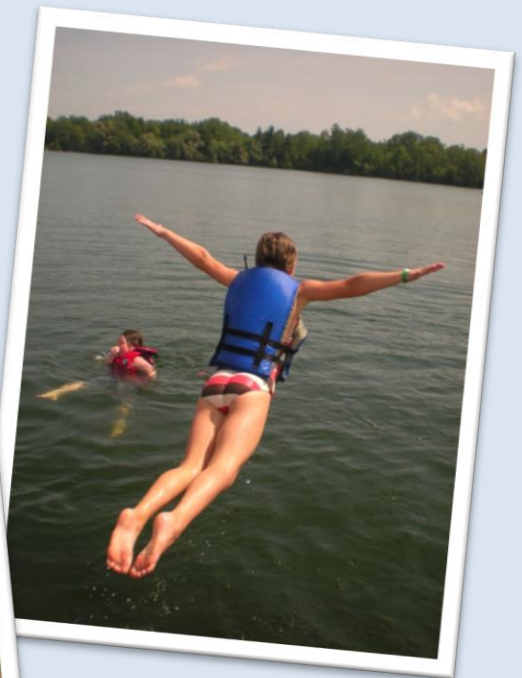
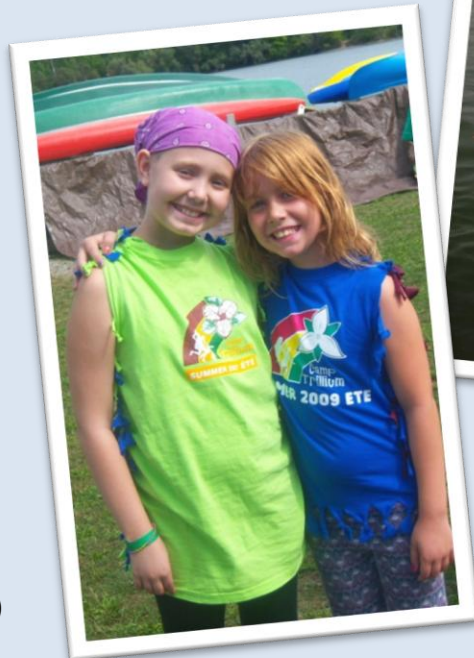

Each group always returns closer and unified. During residential camps, each age groups partakes in a one night overnight in tents and our oldest group goes on a river canoe trip. During family camps this experience is not left out. All kids and families have the option to sign up for the camp out night which is always very popular.

Adventure Program (AP) (High & Low Ropes): Our Adventure Program is incredibly popular with our kids and parents. We have trained instructors and supervisors who run our courses. These courses provide opportunities for parents to see their kids do things they never would have thought possible, and for kids to accomplish goals they never would have dreamed of. Climbing to new heights has a whole new meaning for our kids and families. Seeing the pairs, families and kids accomplish a goal and the look of pure exhilaration and pride on their faces is unmatched.

The Adventure Program is an area at camp that has a constant flow of people and is used all year round, as we have a semi-indoor climbing wall in our Bell Tower. The equipment for AP needs to be special ordered and is in a constant state of renewing. The courses require quite a bit of yearly inspection and maintenance, and they require to have 2 Ast. Instructors and 1 Instructor to open the activity area.
